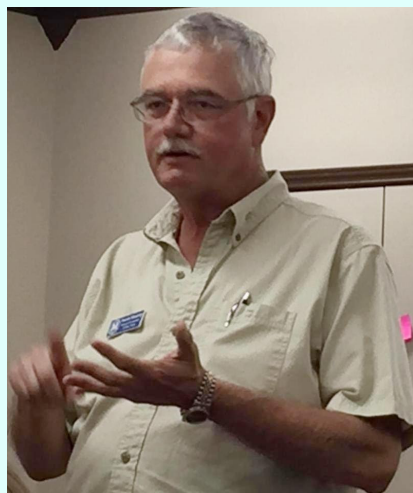
She has earned certifications with the Texas Municipal Clerks Association, Economic Development Finance Professional, Certified Public Manager and Certified Tourism Executive.

### ED BROKAW

Ed Brokaw was born in Pittsfield, Illinois, where he graduated from high school before getting his BS in Animal Science from ACU in 1971. He received his PhD in Animal Breeding and Genetics four years later from Oregon State University.

Ed married Jan in 1970 in Pittsfield, and they are parents of Lori Muzquiz, Lisa Bailey, and Bryan Brokaw (member and two-time president of the Wylie East Fork Rotary club in the metroplex) and grandparents to Todd, Jillian, Luke, Brylee, Lynlie and Presley.

Ed has worked at General Telephone Company, ACCO Feeds, Oregon State University, and at ACU where he is Bray Cook Professor of Animal Science and chair of the Department of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences.

Spare time revolves around golf, reading, grandchildren and family, though other activities take plenty: He is an Elder at Minter Lane Church of Christ, member of the Taylor County Extension Advisory Committee, Secretary of Agriculture Consortium of Texas, and board chair of Consortium of Agricultural



Dr. John Hill, professor of economics, was employed by Hardin-Simmons University in 1998. He received his Bachelor of Business Administration degree in economics from Baylor University. He earned a Master of Arts degree in economics from Texas Christian University and completed his graduate studies at the University of Tennessee with a Ph.D. in economics.

Prior to arriving at Hardin-Simmons University, he was an assistant professor of economics for two years at Northeastern State University in Tahlequah, Oklahoma, and a visiting professor of economics at the University of Tennessee.

Dr. Hill is a real estate investor and owns multifamily and commercial real estate in Abilene. He is a real estate broker and co-owner of Barnett & Hill Real Estate. His brokerage often employs students from Hardin-Simmons and provides them real-world exposure to real estate.

Outside of his work life, Hill serves as a trustee at the University of the South at Sewanee, a volunteer at Breakfast on Beech Street, and is an usher at the Church of the Heavenly Rest.
